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|  |  | - An athlete will only race $3 x$ against the athlete from 3 other countries in the same bracket <br> Lots will be drawn by the 8 athletes (male and female) to determine which bracket they belong to (Athlete 1 bracket or Athlete 2 bracket) In each athlete bracket, single round roundrobin head-to-head matches <br> - No cross-over between athletes of different brackets <br> - Lots will be drawn to determine order of play (alternating between Athlete 1 and 2 brackets) <br> - The choice of lane (1 or 2), for every match-up, shall be by coin toss The 4 fastest times (4 athletes among the 8 athletes) will move to the Finals | - 4 head-to-head matches each for male and female categories (total of 8 match-ups) <br> - An athlete will only race twice <br> - Order of play (Top 3-4, then Top 1-2) <br> - For $1^{\text {st }}$ matchup, choice of lane by coin toss ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ matchup, switch lanes) <br> - The winner shall be based on best of 2 attempts/runs (not accumulated time) <br> - Medal presentation follows |
